I/We are fully aware of the type of re-enactment carried out by the Federation and fully accept the risks, safety procedures and subsequent implications of allowing the above named young person to take part in the re-enactment.

I/We understand and accept the following as listed below:

1. Children under the age of 13 years will not be allowed on the area designated for battle or take part in battle re-enactment, once the combat has started.
2. Children and young persons of 13, 14, and 15 years of age will not take part in hand to hand combat and will be designated non combatants.
3. Children and young persons of 13, 14, and 15 years of age can however take part as archers, gunners assistants, banner bearers, drummers and water carriers, but only when:
  - a. Not on or near the main battle lines
  - b. Not on the losing side unless having a safe route off the field
  - c. Safely to the rear of combat
  - d. Under the direct supervision of an adult
  - e. Clearly identified and are made know to other re-enactors
  - f. Wearing a white sash provided by Parent/Guardian
  - g. Carry no side arms

PLEASE NOTE: IF ANY OF THE ABOVE POINTS CANNOT PRACTICALLY BE PUT INTO PLACE FOR ANY REASON AS DICTATED BY THE CLIENT, LAYOUT OF THE BATTLE FIELD ETC. THE HEALTH & SAFETY OFFICER TOGETHER WITH THE FEDERATION COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE PARTICIPATION DURING BATTLE DISPLAY OF THE CHILD OR YOUNG PERSON.
